By participating in the competition, the participant agrees to the electronic storage, processing, and transfer of competition-related personal data including name, club name, state association affiliation, age, class, competition designation, starting number, and starting time. This processing is carried out in accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR. ## Competition Venue

The Dr. Otto Fahr SWIM-Meeting will take place at the Sportbad Neckarpark in Stuttgart – Bad Cannstatt.

The Address is: Lenore-Volz-Str. 2, 70372 Stuttgart.

Technical Details:

1. The competition pool is 50 meters long and has 8 lanes, separated by wave-breaking lane-dividers. The water depth is consistently 1.80 meters.
2. The water temperature is approximately 26°C.
3. The warm-up and cool-down pool is 25-meter long and has five lanes. This pool can be used throughout the entire event.
4. Electronic time keeping with a time display for eight lanes.
5. The timing system has electronic touchpads on both sides and features track starting blocks.
6. Backstroke aids will be used for all backstroke events.
7. The competition pool has a large spectator grandstand.
8. The start of the champions' race will be signaled by a starting light.

## Starting authorization

1. Swimmers of all clubs affiliated with the DSV or any foreign club whose national swimming federation is affiliated with World Aquatics are authorized to take part in this competition.
2. Entries are accepted for swimmers born 2016 or before.
3. For events, 101 - 108, no entries are accepted for swimmers born in 2016 or after.
4. Swimmers born in 2016 may not participate in more than 6 events per day including final participations, according to §9.2 WB-AT decided by the specialist committee swimming of the DSV.
5. The organizer will conduct a review of the incoming registrations to the best of their ability; however, the responsibility for compliance with youth protection regulations lies with the registering clubs.

## Limitation of Entries

The event has a limit on participants and entries in the interest of the active participants and the sport. With this, SV Cannstatt 1898 e.V. aims to provide athletes an attractive event. The organizer can limit the number of entries in each session and will reject entries upon reaching the upper limits. The decisive factor is the timely receipt of entries at the registration address.

## Everything about the entries, heat and lane assignment and results

1. For German clubs, only the registration file in the current DSV standard is accepted. Foreign clubs use the forms of the German Swimming Federation at the

When submitting the registrations, it is mandatory that the address, telephone number, and email address of the person responsible for the registration (requirement of the authority) are submitted as well. Registrations with missing data will not be considered.

## Free Starts

Competitors who have won the German championship title at the competitions "German Championships", DKM, DM, and DJM in the year 2025 are exempt from the entry fee. Proof must be submitted with the registration along with an extract from the protocol.

## Running restrictions, running establishment, deregistrations

1. For the events 101 – 103 and 106 – 108, we reserve the right to limit the competition and to allow double lane occupancy. For session 1, entry lists will be created for events 101 – 103 and 106 – 108. Cancellations for session 1 can be made until Thursday, 23<sup>th</sup> April 2026, at 9 pm via E-Mail to [melde-service@sv-cannstatt.de](mailto:melde-service@sv-cannstatt.de). After that, the heat and lane assignments for session 1 will be published online.
2. Further free cancellations for sessions 2-5 (except for the 400m freestyle, see point 5.) are only possible until Sunday, 19<sup>th</sup> April 2026, at 23:59 CET by email (registration address).
3. Lane assignments will be made according to § 123 WB and the entry time specified in the registrations (§ 121 WB). The fastest heats in session 1 will start first, and this order will continue.
4. The organizer reserves the right to adjust the age groups depending on the number of entries.
5. The 400 m freestyle will be set with an entry list. Clubs can make cancellations at the speaker's table or via E-Mail at [melde-service@sv-cannstatt.de](mailto:melde-service@sv-cannstatt.de) until the end of session 1 on Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> April 2026, using the cancellation forms.

## Starting rule, track counter

1. The operation of the track counters is carried out by the clubs. The user/club representative is responsible for the correct execution.
2. According to § 125, paragraph 6 WB, the "One-Start Rule" applies for the entire event.
3. Access to the starting bridge is only permitted for authorized persons.

## Kampfgericht

1. A double jury will be appointed for the entire event.
2. The number of judges to be appointed is determined by the number of participants registered by each club and session. The following key\* will be applied per session. The number of judges published in the heat and lane assignment per club is binding. Foreign clubs must provide a judges if the number of registrations exceeds 45.
3. The working times of the judges are as specified for each announced session.

## Ranking, victory ceremony and distinction

1. The ranking for the individual competitions is done by age groups for the years 2016 to 2009 individually, the years 2008 and 2007 are combined as juniors, and the years 2006 and older are grouped together as an open class. Competitions 101 to 103 and 106 to 108 are scored openly.

2. The top three receive medals: 1. Gold | 2. Silver | 3. Bronze.

3. Victory ceremonies for the finals and the champions race will take place as indicated in the programme. The time schedule of the victory ceremonies of the age groups is communicated in due time. Medals that cannot be awarded during a ceremony will be collected at the information booth until the end of the event and will be distributed to a representative of each club at the information booth at the end of the event.

4. Swimmers must attend the victory ceremonies to obtain their medals & prizes.

5. The certificates will be made available for download on the event homepage "https://ottofahr.sv-cannstatt.de" as a PDF file per Club after the event.

7. Multi-event ranking for the age groups 2014-2016. Four distances are ranked: 1x 100m, 1x 200m, 200m individual medley, 400m freestyle (e.g. 100S + 200S + 200L + 400F). The ranking is done by age group through the addition of points from the 4 individual distances according to the WA points table (50m). The winner of each age group receives a trophy. The second and third place winners will be honored with medals.

Please note, the 2016 age group is not allowed to swim 200 m butterfly.

## Inclusion

For the disabled, additional competition regulations of the German Disabled Sports Association (DBS) are to be applied with the appropriate proof of classification.

100 m distances.

All other distances are direct decisions.

The eight fastest swimmers qualify for the final in the 100 m events in the specified age categories, plus five alternates. A withdrawal must be made within 20 minutes after the announcement of the finalists, in writing at the announcer's desk by the participant or a club representative.

## Liability

The organizer and the bath operations are not liable for lost items, damages, or injuries. Glass bottles or other fragile glass items are not allowed in the pool area.

## Access to the competition venue, accreditations and spectators

All participants will be accredited.

Accreditations are issued to the athletes coaches and Team Manger at the Welcome Desk. Accreditations must be picked up before entering the swimming pool and must be always worn. Athletes and coaches are not granted access to the swimming pool without accreditation.

Misuse of accreditations can lead to the immediate exclusion of the affected individuals from the competition. Spectators are allowed to enter the event through the spectator area (without street shoes). Staying in the competition area is prohibited.

## Final Information

2. Chairs and mats must be removed from the event area after each session. Left equipment will be disposed of. The organizer does not set up a lost and found.

4. Instructions from the lifeguard staff and the organizer must be followed.

5. Emergency and escape routes must always be kept clear. Staircases may not be used as seating (emergency and escape routes).

## **RULES FOR THE CHAMPIONS RACE: WK 550**

Qualified participants must report to the speaker's table and confirm their participation. For each discipline, 3 alternates will be nominated.

### **1. Participant field**

1.1 consist of the four fastest participants in the women's and men's 100m disciplines (heats)

1.2 The decision to participate in the Champions Race must be made immediately after a possible qualification in the race. According to a cancellation, the next substitute qualifies.

1.3 The number of substitutes is limited to 5. Otherwise, WB § 131 para. 15 applies / In case of a tie, a swim-off will determine participation in the final race; WB § 131 para. 16.

1.4 If a participant has qualified in more than one event, the highest score achieved according to World Aquatics is determined. The event with the highest score is then the qualifying event. There is no option for free choice!

### **2. Implementation determination**

2.1 A total of 3 rounds will be started.

2.2 Each finalist swims in their qualifying position.

2.3 Exit times are always the heat time.

2.4 The lane assignment is done in reverse order: Lane 4 - slowest time --> Lane 8 - fastest time.

1.5 The start is staggered. Track 4 – 5 – 3 – 6 – 2 – 7 – 1 – 8; the start intervals represent the time differences to the achieved qualification times -Pt.1.1-/2.3-

2.6 Central gaps are occupied by moving forward. The field converges (if technically possible).

2.7 After each round, there is a break of 3 minutes. Relaxed swimming is allowed after the last participant touches the wall.

### **3. Round 1 and 2**

3.1 After each round, the two last-placed participants are eliminated.

3.2 In the case of simultaneous timing of several actions, they remain in competition.

3.3 If 3.2 occurs, the starting field will increase in the next round, and after 2.1, the process will continue.

#### 4. Round 3

4.1 Here start the remaining 4 competitors, except for item 3.2, there is an

4.2 This round will start in the same mode as rounds 1 and 2.

4.3 If no winner can be determined, for example by target impact, restarting will continue until a winner is determined.

#### 5. Care

5.1 Every starter is allowed to be supported by a supervisor on the starting bridge.

#### 6. Rating

The - Champions-Race- is won by the swimmer of the last round through a finish touch. The winner receives €200.00 / 3 free entries\*, the runner-up €120.00 / 2 free entries\*, and the third place €60.00 / 1 free entry\* for the next Int. Dr. Otto Fahr SWIM-MEETING\*. If a swimmer wins all 3 rounds, an additional bonus of €150.00 will be awarded. If none of the competitors achieve this, the bonus will be added to the ranking of the next Int. Dr. Otto Fahr SWIM-MEETING and increase the jackpot for this mode.

\*The entries are non-transferable.
